



Day 1: Nairobi

Your driver/guide from Roaming Africa Tours and Safaris will receive you at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and transfer you to Panafric Hotel for overnight. Accommodation based on bed and breakfast.

Meal: Bed and Breakfast

Accommodation: Panafric Hotel

Day 2: Nairobi – Samburu

Depart Nairobi on this second day of **honeymoon safari in Kenya** and drive through central Kenya and north across the equator to Samburu National Reserve arriving Samburu Sopa Lodge in time for lunch. Afternoon game drives.

Meal: Lunch, Dinner and Breakfast

Accommodation: Samburu Sopa Lodge

Day 3: Samburu

Full day in Samburu, a beautiful and game abundant park, home to rarely found species such as the Beisa Oryx, Grevy's zebra, blue-necked Somali ostrich and reticulated giraffe. Morning and afternoon game drives with an optional visit to a local Samburu village to learn the culture of the Samburu community (You'll pay USD30 per person).

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Samburu Sopa Lodge

Day 4: Samburu – Aberdares National Park

After breakfast, depart for Aberdares National Park. Arrive at Outspan Hotel in Nyeri for the 1330hrs transfer to Treetops Lodge. The Treetops Lodge overlooks a floodlit waterhole and salt lick which attracts a host of awesome wildlife at night and tourists view the wildlife from the balcony of their rooms or lodge verandah.

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Treetops Lodge

Day 5: Aberdares – Lake Nakuru National Park

After breakfast, a representative of Tree Tops Lodge will transfer you back to Outspan Hotel where you'll reconnect with your driver/guide and depart for Lake Nakuru with a brief stop at

Nyahururu Thompson Falls. Then proceed to Lake Nakuru. Lunch at Flamingo Tented Hill Camp. Afternoon game drives in the park. Besides the flamingos that the lake is famous for, there are approx 400 other species of birds visiting the lake. Also, many species of game can be found in the park including the introduced Rothschild's giraffe, black and white rhino, waterbuck, reedbuck, lion, buffalo, leopard, baboon and many species of plains game.

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Flamingo Tented Hill Camp

Day 6: Lake Nakuru - Masai Mara Game Reserve

After breakfast depart for Maasai Mara arriving in time for lunch at Mara Sopa Lodge. Masai Mara Game Reserve has a high concentration of wildlife and outstanding scenic views. Afternoon game viewing drives.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Mara Sopa Lodge



Day 7: Masai Mara

Full day game viewing in this typical savannah country a well-known site for various wildlife movies. Optional visit Manyatta villages where Masai tribesmen live to learn their culture and dance. You'll pay USD30 per person per visit to the village.



Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Mara Sopa Lodge

Day 8: Masai Mara - Lake Naivasha

After breakfast, depart for Lake Naivasha. Naivasha is one of the gems in a necklace of Rift Valley lakes, has a variety of bird life and hippo colonies. Lunch at Lake Naivasha Sopa Resort and afternoon visit to Hell's Gate Park. Activities include hiking, rock climbing, spectacular gorge walks, bird watching and wildlife viewing. Sunset boat ride at Lake Naivasha (you'll pay this directly to boat owners depending on the rides you take). The lodge charges \$30 per person for boat ride per hour.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Lake Naivasha Sopa Resort

Day 9: Lake Naivasha - Nairobi - Amboseli

After breakfast, depart for Amboseli National Park. Lunch at Amboseli Sopa Lodge. The lodge is the only one in Amboseli which gives tourists the best view of the snow-capped Mt Kilimanjaro at dawn. Late afternoon game drives in search of herds of elephants, giraffes, lions, and a variety of other animals and birds.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Amboseli Sopa Lodge



Day 10: Amboseli National Park

Full day in Amboseli with morning and afternoon game drives. You'll have an option to visit Masai villages to learn their culture and dance. The Masai dancers charge a fee and you'll pay this directly if you opt to go there. Visit Masai Village in the evening to learn their culture and dance (at a cost of USD30 per person per visit and you'll pay this directly to the Masai Village).

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Amboseli Sopa Lodge

Day 11: Amboseli - Tsavo West

After breakfast, drive to Tsavo West National Park. Lunch at Ngulia Safari Lodge and later set off for afternoon game drives.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Ngulia Safari Lodge

Day 12: Tsavo West - Tsavo East

After breakfast, you'll depart for the vast wilderness of Tsavo East, Kenya's oldest and largest park. Lunch at Voi Safari Lodge. Afternoon game drives exploring the park where we can



expect to see elephant, lion, leopard, buffalo, kudu, zebra and hartebeest.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Voi Safari Lodge

Day 13: Tsavo East - Mombasa

Breakfast and morning game drive. After lunch, drive down to the coast and drop you at Baobab Beach Resort & Spa at Ukunda, South Coast. Accommodation at Baobab Beach Resort & Spa will be on full board.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Accommodation: Baobab Beach Resort & Spa

Day 14-15: Mombasa, Ukunda

You spend the days at the beach sunbathing or engaged in the numerous water sports that are available including: - Scuba diving, snorkeling, wind surfing, big game fishing and deep sea dive. Activities are at your own cost.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Baobab Beach Resort & Spa

Day 16: Mombasa - Depart Home

After breakfast, a representative of Baobab Beach Resort & Spa will transfer you to Ukunda Airstrip to catch your flight to Moi International Airport, Mombasa, to connect with your international flight home.
